

Dance Attire

Proper attire and neatness enables students to concentrate on instruction and teachers to correct alignment. A leotard must be worn at all times, without fancy tutus attached. No street clothes may be worn. Jewelry should be limited for safety and discipline. Hair must be pulled neatly off the face, preferably in a bun. **"A NEAT DANCER MAKES A GOOD PERFORMER."** *Uniforms are worn for sports why not for dance class!*

Preschool Combination Classes Ages 3- 6

Leotard: Black or Pink (any style)

Tights: Theatrical Pink

Shoes: Ballet Slippers- Pink

Tap Shoes- Capezio Mary Jan Tan #3800 with elastic, Velcro, or buckles. NO ribbons.

Dance Skirts and Sweater Wraps: Pink, black or white may also be worn for class. (Optional)

Combination Classes Ages 7- 12

Leotard: Black or Pink; Black Jazz Pants

Tights: Theatrical Pink or Classic Light Toast

Shoes: Ballet Slippers- Pink (may also be worn for Jazz) or Caramel Jazz Shoes- CG- 15 (Dansneaker- DS11)

Tap Shoes- Capezio Mary Jané Tan #3800

Beginner Hip Hop & Street Jazz/ Funk Classes

Leotard: Must be worn at all times. Any color or style. With Black Jazz Pants. (Shirts can be worn as well. No belly shirts)

Classes Offered

PRESCHOOL- Must be at least 3 years old by December and be potty trained.

A tremendous aid in school preparedness, dance instructions during the formative years better equips a child physically for any later type of activity than almost any other kind of training. Preschool classes help develop individual personalities, a sense of rhythm feeling of movement, coordination, group participation and taking direction.

BALLET- Through the classic art of ballet, your child will develop grace, coordination, and poise, a disciplined control of the body, an appreciation for music and art, and a wonderful sense of accomplishment. Emphasis is placed on proper technique, posture, and body position. It provides the foundation needed to pursue jazz, tap, gymnastics, ice skating and even sports! Pointe shoes will only be offered to students with 5 years or more of ballet training and only by the teacher recommendation.

LYRICAL- This beautiful contemporary dance form incorporates jazz & ballet along with a modern dance technique, while maintaining classical lines and movement. Offered to students 8 years old and up.

BROADWAY JAZZ- Musical Theatre style, emphasizing freedom of movement and creative self-expression, fast moving jazz is a great aid in achieving physical fitness. "Jazz" originated in America and is most popular on television and stage.

HIP HOP- The ultimate in fun and fitness. An evolving combination of rhythmic isolations jumps and turns done to current music and pop sensations.

STREET JAZZ FUNK- An evolving combination of hip hop, street and jazz dancing, describes the types of dance that students will emulate from their favorite MTV music video.

TAP- Designed to develop rhythm, coordination, balance and agility. Tap dancing became popular in the 1930's with Vaudeville, then later to cinema and stage.

VOICE- Recommended for ages 8 and up. Vocal exercises are taught along with techniques and songs used to improve the voice in all styles. Prepares the student wanting to audition for school plays and gives them the confidence to perform in front of an audience.

MUSICAL THEATRE- Experience the fun of musical theatre! Learn the moves from Broadway and the music videos of your favorite artists. Develop your skills, and build your confidence while learning the dance routines and voice techniques you need to be a great performer.

ENROLLMENT POLICIES

Please read the following policies before registering.

Registration represents a financial commitment through the end of the school year.

There is a \$20.00 non-refundable registration fee per family for all new students due upon registration.

TUITION IS BASED ON A YEARLY RATE. No deductions can be made for missed classes due to vacations, sports and school activities.

There are 4 option payments to choose from:

1. FULL payment for the year with a 5% discount when paid by Sept. 15th
2. Three QUARTERLY payments made on Sept. 15th, Jan. 15th & April 15th.
3. AUTOMATIC Payment taken out the 1st of every month with a Visa, MasterCard or Debit card on file.
4. MONTHLY payments due on the first of each month. First payment due includes the one time Registration Fee and the payments of September and June Tuition.

CANCELLED CLASSES- Cancelled classes for inclement weather will be on the voice mail message 2 hours prior to class. Make up classes will be scheduled accordingly.

ANNUAL RECITAL- Is held at the end of June. Date and location will be determined by December. Our annual performance is not mandatory, however dance is a performance art, and to complete the learning experience, students need a chance to show their hard work. We emphasize the job and fun of performing.

COSTUMES- for our show need to be ordered by January therefore full payment is due by December 15th and 50% Deposit is due by November 15th. Students will be measured in December and parents will be asked to approve their child's size before ordering. Lengths on costumes are left undone so that if the student grows in that 6 month period they can be cut or hemmed. Any alterations are the responsibility of the student.

RECITAL TICKETS AND FEES- Recital fee is \$120 per family. Includes six recital tickets, three dress rehearsal tickets, a CD (audio music) of the students' routines. Additional tickets may be purchased for \$15.00. Tickets go on Sale in May and all seats are reserved.

OBSERVATION OF CLASSES
Classes may be observed at any time in the waiting room area with our convenient TV monitor. With the permission of the teacher, parents and grandparents are always welcome to come in and take photos or video during their child's class.
